IFYE USA NATIONAL UPDATE

We are proud to announce that Rebecca Pratt of Hopedale (Tazewell County) was selected last month as a candidate for the Compeer Financial scholarship. Becca graduated from the University of Illinois in May 2021 and farms with her dad. She brings a keen interest in international travel and desire to learn more about international agriculture. The selection committee of Larry Wachtell, Dale Yonker, Karen Schieler of Compeer Financial and Carolyn Hansen is confident Becca will represent Illinois well.

We are hoping to have both inbound and outbound IFYEs for the first time in three years. If you know of youth whose families are involved in soybean farming, we are still looking for candidates. The entire program fee is paid for the candidate.

We are also seeking another candidate in northwestern Illinois to participate as a COMPEER FINANCIAL participant. The candidate will receive a \$2,000 scholarship to apply to the participant fee. 
