Staffing Update:

As announced in the January 2017 update, the Board is seeking an interested, qualified individual to become the Executive Director of the IFYE Association of the USA, Inc. Program Update:

Alan Lambert, National Program Director, reports that currently six US IFYEs have been selected and placed in 8 different countries, and more applications are expected. Most US IFYEs are on the six-month program and will live in two host countries. More slots are available. We have received inbound IFYE commitments from 9 different countries and expect approximately 20 total inbounds. Most will be on the three-month (June 19 - September 5) program. Placements with host states are beginning.

Financial Update:

THANK YOU for your continuing support of IFYE in 2017. While we are working to find an Executive Director to manage fundraising, we need more donations early in the year to assure no break in our support of the 2017 IFYE experience for inbounds and outbounds. The 2017 operating budget of \$305,720 for 15 outbound IFYEs and 23 inbound IFYEs is less than \$100 per IFYE alumni in the database.

Now that all 2016 donations are received and recorded, we are pleased to let you know that those donations totaled \$195,201. A special thanks to both the IFYEs who went in 1968 for their pledge to donate \$26,150 collectively and the rest of our members who responded to their challenge.

There are multiple ways to donate.

Discussed in previous updates are:

1. Setting up a recurring monthly* donation.
2. Selecting IFYE USA as your charitable organization for Amazon Smile Match* donations.
3. Writing a check or using a credit card* on any schedule that fits your budget (for example annually or quarterly)

4. Donating from your IRA if you are over 70½ years of age. This avoids taxation of your RMD (Required Minimum Distribution – formerly known as Minimum Required Distribution). If you turned 70½ in 2016 you have until April 1, 2017 to receive your RMD. Regardless of when you became (or become) 70½, talk to your tax advisor about how to donate your RMD tax-free directly from your IRA to IFYE USA.

Another way to donate is to make a memorial or honor gift* in the name of a fellow IFYE, host family member, friend of IFYE, or someone else who cared (cares) about IFYE. When a loved one dies, consider naming the IFYE Association of the USA as a recipient of memorial gifts.

Donations by credit card can be completed at the <http://ifyeusa.org> website by clicking on “Ways to Give” and “Make a Donation.” Donations can be one-time or monthly-recurring, whichever you prefer. Remember \$100 per alumni (which is less than \$10 per month) would exceed our annual budget.
