# **Financial Update:**

In the last issue, it was shared that the operating budget needs were going to likely make it necessary to borrow additional money from the membership account at Raymond James. But thanks to the generous gift of \$20,000 from an anonymous IFYE alum we will be able to meet our current expenses and actually pay back \$10,000 that was previously borrowed! Thank you.

As you might expect with the change in the Finance Committee chair and the possible addition of an Executive Director, the 2017 and 2018 budgets are being closely reviewed.

The amount needed to operate for the rest of 2017 which includes the exchange program and administration is sizable. However, if each IFYE Alum would donate \$10.00 per month we would exceed our budget!! That's correct, if each alumnus could donate \$100 per year or \$10.00 per month, your choice, financially we would meet our needs.
