

IFYE UPDATE – September 2024

2024 IFYE Program Renewed in Chile as Pilot Project

We are pleased that we have been able to re-partner with Chile as a sending and receiving partner for fall 2024 with six inbounds and four outbounds. (Our earlier programs with Chile show 34 outbounds between 1951 to 2010.)

A brief schedule is listed below. More will be shared in our later publications yet this year.

- Sept 23 –24 Inbounds and Outbounds arrive in DC for orientation
- Sept 24-25 Orientation program with Chilean Inbounds going to their respective states and USA outbounds going to Chile on September 25.

Inbounds will stay with their host families through Thanksgiving before returning to Chile. Inbound hosting states are Virginia, Colorado, Kansas, and Illinois.

Outbounds will go to Santiago, Chile for two days of orientation in the country which will include a visitation to the USA Embassy. This will be followed by technical school and home stays in this host country. Outbounds will be in Chile for three months and are from Virginia, Colorado, and Illinois.
