Organizational Capacity Campaign (OCC) Reaches Goal!

With the strong support of alumni across the country, the **40 pledges** of \$5,000 per year for 2018, 2019 and 2020 **have been obtained**. Those who made pledges will be receiving information soon on the details for honoring their support to IFYE. **Thank you**!

With the completion of this project, the Executive Director will be able to answer the concerns of Foundations, prospective business and corporate donors when they ask if the IFYE Association is financially secure.

Thank you to all who were able to participate in the OCC and also to those who considered the campaign but decided to provide a smaller donation to the operating fund.

Financial Update:

The national budget for 2018 contains alumni donations of \$11,500 in the income section. That is less than \$100 per alumni per year, or \$10 per month. Any non-life member donating \$30 or more will be credited as an annual member when they make the donation. Regular general contributions to IFYE remain a vital component for the success of our association.

Program Update:

Eight Outbound IFYEs completed their twice monthly conference orientation calls which have occurred for the last several months. Six additional outbound IFYEs are being sought for a September 2018 departure. If you know of a candidate, please let us know by calling Alan Lambert, National Program Director at 605-366-6107.

This year the IFYE Board initiated a \$500 incentive to anyone who recruits a person that completes the IFYE interview, is selected, completes the national IFYE orientation and lands in the host country. If multiple persons are designated by the IFYE as being responsible for their participation, the \$500 will be divided between those named. **Up to \$500 per IFYE recruited is available for you!!**

The National IFYE Orientation will occur in Washington DC from June 14-18, 2018. The eight outbound IFYEs will be joined for this event by 17 inbound IFYEs from nine countries.

Orientation activities include:

• A full-day workshop led by Sarah Lanier, consultant and author of "Foreign to Familiar." Sarah gave us a riveting keynote address at the 2017 National IFYE Conference in Orlando last August. Her workshop will focus on cultural and sensitivity differences.

• The Foreign Agriculture Service (FAS) will prepare the Outbound IFYEs with information on international trade and the effects of recent trade sanctions. In-country contact with FAS officers will be encouraged.

• A writing workshop, a photography workshop, group presentation development, and a cultural trip to sites in DC will occur before departure.

Program Committee Activities:

The Program Committee is working to provide better support for State IFYE Coordinators in the following ways:

- Implemented a Board approved expense reimbursement program.
- Conducting bi-monthly meetings with State Coordinators.
- Ongoing updates to the coordinator handbook for placement on the Coordinator website portal.
- Established a weekend in October 2018 for a coordinator retreat to build enthusiasm and comradery among the Coordinators and allow them more input into the national program.

The Executive Director, IFYE Board and the Program Director and Program Committee have worked in the last six weeks to begin an IFYE Program Enhancement Project (PEP). Three areas will be enhanced:

- 1. Corporate: (To add business participation through hosting and job shadowing. A pilot program with Syngenta is underway).
- 2. Government: (To strengthen IFYE's relationship with USDA, facilitate understanding of food and fiber aspects of policies in countries and governmental relationships).
- 3. Universities: (To understand production, research and infrastructure of food and fiber education in different countries).
