
A few items to note:

## **RIP Mary Jo Stewart**

Mary Jo Cunningham Stewart, born February 24, 1937, died January 26, 2021 in her sleep. Mary was an IFYE to Peru in 1960. She had served as President of the IL IFYE Association plus other offices. She was Banquet Chairman and Chairman of the Orientation Committee. Mary worked as Extension Adviser in Perry County and later in Macon County. Her youngest son, Greg also was an IFYE and went to Jamacia in 1990. After her husband Jim died, Mary moved to a nursing home in Indiana near her sons, Greg and Mike. The IL IFYE Association extends its sympathy to her family.

## **Contributions to IFYE Endowment**

Some of you have noticed that IFYE Endowment Fund is not listed on the solicitation form many of you receive for contributions to the IL 4-H Foundation. I contacted the 4-H Foundation and received the following responses:

The Illinois 4-H Foundation recently worked to update their website as we wait for a complete redesign by the college. As part of this effort, we also aligned our giving options to those state priorities that support the largest efforts currently in place. There is absolutely no way to list all 49 endowments options or the 120 some current use funds that we are charged with administering.

During this process, I did inquire about having the option to list "OTHER" on the giving page and have been granted permissions by the IT and University of Illinois Foundation programming team to get this in place. That will make it much easier for people to give to specific funds, like the IFYE endowment. I am just waiting for this to be programmed and tested prior to implementation on the website. I hope to see it in early 2021.

I hope to see this option on future solicitation forms soon.



## Update on IL 4-H & International

I also received the following notice from Angie Barnard of the IL 4-H Foundation:

- Lisa Diaz recently met with Carolyn Hanson to talk about how to promote IFYE as a valuable experience to our 4-H alumni network. Tina Veal is working with Carolyn to include updates on opportunities.
- Lisa was recently identified as the US representative to the 4-H Global Network Board she is interested in continuing to grow international experiences for youth as 4-H members (up to age 18) and beyond (as alumni).
- Food security and sustainability are the themes of the upcoming 4-H Global Network Summit in Tanzania – IL 4-H Specialist, Mark Becker, and team of collaborators have an accepted proposal to share our 4-H Food Action Academy Initiative at that summit. Was scheduled for August 2020 but postponed due to COVID. The hosting country is hopeful to hold in summer 2021 but still in holding pattern.
- 2020 4-H Youth in Action Pillar Winner, Janya Green from GA, identified as vice chair for a track of the planned 2021 Food and Agricultural Organization summit in Rome.

Many things to be excited about and we appreciate your efforts and the IFYE Association's desires to continue this important work!
