Program Update:

The 2018 IFYE program is progressing more each day. Our goal is to have more than 15 applications by March 20, 2018. After interviews, we hope to have 12 qualified IFYEs selected from the applicant pool. Contact with over 86 individuals who have expressed interest in the IFYE program in the past two years continues daily by phone, text, email and other electronic messaging. Three individuals have been interviewed and selected as 2018 IFYEs, and nearly 10 others have given verbal commitments to apply in 2018.

Recruitment will continue. Your help in identifying interested young adults and helping them apply will be an outstanding example of your commitment to the IFYE program. As you may recall, a recruiting incentive of up to \$500 is available to anyone who recruits an applicant, who is interviewed, and selected, and then completes the orientation and arrives in their host country.

Additionally, IFYE is being promoted in the next three weeks at four state Young Farmers and Ranchers Conferences, at the 2018 Minorities in Agriculture, Natural Resources and Related Sciences (MANRRS) conference and university chapters, and through ongoing IFYE presentations by the recently returned 2017 IFYEs.

A total of 19 countries will participate in the 2018 IFYE program, including recent additions of Argentina, Jamaica and Poland. The US will send IFYEs to The Philippines beginning in 2019.

Board Update:

- Work continues for replacing the IFYE Excel database with a client management system. A plan of work to implement the change will likely be finalized in February.
- A revision of committee and staff reporting was approved by the board. The new report format will focus on results accomplished more than activity done during the reporting period.
- Contracts for all staff members and contractors have been signed for 2018.
- The 2018 National Board meeting will be in Indianapolis, Indiana, on July 6-8. Location to be determined.

Financial Update:

- The December 2017 donations made the month positive; income exceeded expenses. Outside funding sources being worked on by the Executive Director will hold the need for alumni contributions to \$10,000 per month. If half of the IFYE alumni donated just \$10 per month, the income would be almost double the need!
- It is recognized that many of you make donations. We greatly appreciate your generosity and want you to continue your support. Historically donations have exceeded the \$10,000 per month alumni portion of the budget. We need that to continue.

The Organizational Capacity Campaign is progressing nicely. Eighteen (18) have verbally pledged to donate \$5,000 each year for the next 3-years (2018, 2019 and 2020). The target deadline is now February 7, 2018. Monies donated to fulfill the pledge are tax-deductible and will be placed in a separate bank account. Use of these funds is restricted to organizational expansion as outlined in a separate budget, which is available upon request.

If you are one of those persons that are concerned about the new tax laws placing you in a position where your donations cannot be itemized, consider donating directly from your IRA, teacher's retirement, or other qualified savings account and avoid taxation on that donation completely! If you are over the age of 70, that is possible. Donations do not have to be made now. In fact, we do not want your money now! What is needed is the pledge and when you intend to make the donation to IFYE within the next three years.
