# Mark Zeug Matching Challenge & Annual Giving Campaign (AGC)

We owe a big thank you to Mark Zeug for offering a matching gift of \$25,000. We reached that goal quickly. I'm sure that Mark is grateful that you honored his wife Helene, in this manner. We also reached our AGC goal with an additional **\$52,886** in donations. These gifts, totaling \$102,901, will be used for program and operating expenses.

#### 2024 Chile Pilot

Although we said we were not going to have an exchange in 2024, the Agriculture Attache of Chile contacted us to let us know that after two years of collaborating with him, their government and the appropriate NGO organization wanted to move ahead with sending six young adults to the United States. Glenda Snyder and Barbara Spangler, State Coordinators of Virginia IFYE, were already set to send two people who had applied to be IFYEs and were disappointed they could not go.

With help from Pat Hutsell, Deryl Waldren and Keith Ferris, we found two more IFYEs to participate. We called coordinators of states we knew had candidates ready to go.

Unfortunately, because of the timing they were unable to join the exchange. Thank you to all the host families who shared their family and culture with our Chilean IFYEs. We know it is quite different to have an IFYE during the fall, but it all worked out and everyone had meaningful experiences.

#### 2025 - Chilean Pilot Year Two

Because of the success of the program, Chilean officials jumped at the chance to have a second IFYE exchange. This year we will send eight IFYEs and receive eight Chilean IFYEs. This year, however, it will be during the summer months.

# 2025 Limited Exchange

Because we have long-standing relationships with many countries, we reached out to five countries to see if they would be able to send and receive IFYEs. Two of those countries have given us a "definite maybe," one is going through a restructure like IFYE USA, and two others are

in the middle of the selection process. We are reaching out to other countries trying to arrange a 1:1 exchange in five countries.

### What can you do to help and why should you wish to help?

We know many of you have family members who are 19-30 years old. We also imagine that you may know agriculture students in any one of the 112 Land Grant Universities or other colleges and universities. Please reach out to the possible candidates and try to recruit them. Please keep in mind that agriculture and other majors now require



international experience for graduation. Although the IFYE exchange is longer than what many schools offer, it is also considerably less expensive and IFYEs have been doing this for a long time. College credit may be available but it will require the IFYE to collaborate with their school's counselors/advisors. The Interim National Program Director can help with sending appropriate letters of confirmation of the IFYE's involvement. Your State Coordinators and State Contacts have received, via email, flyers that can be used to help you recruit.

We need 13 IFYEs and encourage you to help us recruit them. Not only will it be good for the IFYEs, but it will also help plead our case to the House and Senate Agriculture Committees for the Farm Bill.

### Bench Strength: Why IFYE Needs You On the Field

The need is particularly acute in certain areas. We are currently lacking a leader for the Alumni Communications Committee (and are actively seeking members for the committee as well). This committee is responsible for the crucial IFYE Updates and IFYE News, ensuring that alumni stay connected and informed (thankfully, our talented editor, Ginny Warner, is still with us).
